

EDI-Link

What is EDI?

EDI (Electronic Data Interchange) is the standard way in which most major retailers (such as Tesco, B&Q & Debenhams) communicate with their suppliers. If you supply these stores then you need to be able cope with this system.



In fact, more and more smaller retailers and wholesale companies are finding the benefits of a fully integrated system that will receive sales orders from their customers and return the invoices to their customers via Electronic Data Interchange (EDI).

Without our EDI-Link, all these orders and invoices have to be manually entered, one by one, into Sage Accounting Software.

If EDI-Link is installed and integrated with the Sage Accounting Software, then an enormous amount of time, effort and money can be saved. The orders are generated in the Sales Order Processing module of the Sage Accounts automatically, hence avoiding any possible re-keying errors. These orders are processed normally within the Sage software to the point where an invoice is created. EDI-Link

then collects the Invoice and passes it back to the customer, again avoiding errors.

What does EDI-Link work with?

EDI-Link works with the leading EDI Management software solutions. Products such as Kewill, GXS and We-Supply all integrate seamlessly with EDI-Link.

Bespoke options can also be added. A supplier to Airbus UK approached us and asked if we could interpret the Airbus file format and automatically write the sales orders into Sage order processing. This was easily achieved as EDI-Link is our software. We made the requested modification and the system has been running successfully for a number of years.
